Item VI. Financials: (Fisher)

A. & B. December 2022 Financial Report and Approval

Ms. Fisher provided the Board with a copy of the December 2022 Financial reports via email before the meeting for their review. During the meeting, Ms. Fisher read through the December 2022 financial reports, read aloud the Profit & Loss Budget vs. the Actual year-to-date comparison, and discussed the Billing Stats and the visit count.

During the financial report review it was shared that there were a few adjustments to be made by the CPA that the financial report was not completely reflecting due to it being the end of the year. During the discussion of the visit count, Ms. Fisher noted the increase in visits for occupational medicine. She predicted the visit count would go up now that the holidays are over.

Mr. Adams had a few questions about collections. Ms. Prest responded with a brief breakdown of percentages collected by PMC. There were no further questions or comments.

Item VII. Medical Director/ Assistant Medical Director/Clinical Coordinator: (Dr. Kotler/Dr. Naeem/Monica Martin)

Dr. William Kotler and Dr. Mohammed Naeem were absent during this board meeting. Ms. Martin gave a brief overview to The Board.

Ms. Martin stated PMC had completed 349 COVID tests, with 68 positives. For Flu, PMC has administered 329 tests with 22 positives. There were 19 RSV tests on children five and under with 0 positive results.

Ms. Martin said there were not as many events due to PMC spending time on their Urgent Care Association Certification and having the Community Health Coordinator on maternity leave. PMC did have a Christmas giveaway with a great turnout. PMC/PPC had very few stockings left after the drive-thru giveaway was completed and gave the remainder to children who came into the facility afterward. PMC/PPC also attended an event in Boothville where LDH administered COVID vaccines and Second Harvest put on a food drive. There were no questions or comments.

Item VIII. New Business: (Adams)

A. To consider and take action with respect to adopting a resolution ordering and calling a special election to be held in Plaquemines ParishHospital Service District Number One, State of Louisiana, to authorize the levy of a special tax therein, making application to the State Bond Commission, and providing for other matters in connection therewith.

Mr. Scandurro passed out the resolution to the board members and read aloud highlighted areas to the board. From there, Mr. Adams read the resolution aloud to the board:

RESOLUTION NO. 23-

A resolution approving the holding of an election in Plaquemines Parish Hospital Service District Number One, State of Louisiana, on Saturday, April 29, 2023, to authorize the levy of a special tax therein.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Plaquemines Parish Hospital Service District Number One, State of Louisiana (the "Governing Authority"), acting as the governing authority of Plaquemines Parish Hospital Service District Number One, State of Louisiana (the "District"), plans to adopt a resolution on January 19, 2023, calling a special election in the District on Saturday, April 29, 2023, to authorize the levy of a special tax therein; and

WHEREAS, the governing authority of the District has requested that this Parish Council, acting as the governing authority of the Parish of Plaquemines, State of Louisiana, give its consent and authority for the District to hold the aforesaid election, and in the event that the election carries to levy and collect the special tax provided for therein; and

WHEREAS, as required by Article VI, Section 15 of the Constitution of the State of Louisiana of 1974, it is now the desire of this Parish Council to approve the holding of said election and in the event that the election carries, to levy and collect the special tax provided for therein;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Plaquemines Parish Council, acting as the governing authority of said Parish, that:

SECTION 1. In compliance with the provisions of Article VI, Section 15 of the Constitution of the State of Louisiana of 1974, and in accordance with the request of the Board of Commissioners of Plaquemines Parish Hospital Service District Number One, State of Louisiana, this Parish Council hereby approves the holding of an election in the District, on Saturday, April 29, 2023, at which election there will be submitted the following proposition, to-wit:

PROPOSITION (IN-LIEU MILLAGE)

Shall Plaquemines Parish Hospital Service District Number One, State of Louisiana (the "District"), a parishwide hospital service district, levy a tax of 2.89 mills on all the property subject to taxation within the District (an estimated \$2,500,000 reasonably expected at this time to be collected from the levy of the tax for an entire year), for a period of fifteen (15) years, beginning with the year 2023 and ending with the year 2037, for the purpose of acquiring, constructing, improving, maintaining and operating public hospital buildings and health care facilities of and for the District, said tax to be in lieu of and completely replace an ad valorem tax currently being levied in Plaquemines Parish at the same rate and for the same purpose as authorized at an election held on May 2, 2009?

SECTION 2. In the event the election carries, this Parish Council hereby consents to and authorizes the District to levy and collect the special tax provided for therein and further agrees and covenants that it will no longer levy the ad valorem tax for public hospital buildings previously approved on May 2, 2009 and currently being levied at the rate of 2.89 mills (the "Current Tax"). It is the express intent of this Parish Council that, in the event the election carries, the Current Tax will be completely replaced by the newly-approved tax.

This resolution having been submitted to a vote, the vote thereon was as follows:
